Review Session

The purpose of the session is to consider how issues raised in the hearing sessions part of the Examination will be taken forward and to discuss how the Examination will proceed hereafter. The questions that the session will address are as follows:

1. What are the key issues that the Inspector needs to consider arising from the hearings part of the examination?
Note – the Inspector will need to reflect on what he has heard at the hearing sessions and then consider the additional information to be provided by the Council. In these respects the Inspector will write to the Council to set out his position on key issues.
2. What further work does the Council need to undertake following the hearings (see Action Lists) and what is the likely timetable for producing the additional work?
3. On the assumption that there is the potential for modifications to rectify soundness, what Main Modifications (MMs) (those modifications necessary to make the LP sound) have arisen in the examination process so far, particularly from the hearings?
4. Does the Council wish the Inspector to recommend any MMs that he considers are necessary to resolve any issues of ‘unsoundness’?
5. What is the process for the Council taking forward the MMs including any need for sustainability appraisal and public consultation?
6. How should the Schedule of MMs be set out?
7. What is the status of Additional Modifications?
8. What is the likely timetable for the remainder of the Examination including further consultation and the Inspector’s report?
9. What is the role of the Programme Officer after the close of the hearings?
10. Are there any questions on the likely examination process post-hearings?
11. Close of the hearings.
